PICTOU WEST NEEDS A NEW LIBRARY! The current facility no longer meets community needs, cannot deliver the services and programs of a modern library, and is not accessible.

An expanded facility, hosting a new library, will draw 30-50% more patrons, having a multi-million dollar impact on downtown expenditures.


We believe that Pictou County can grow its creative sector by bringing together multiple arts organizations under one roof. Performing, literary and visual arts will come together and partnerships will flourish.

The deCoste sells 23,000 tickets annually, and we expect to reach 30,000 by 2025. We need to plan for growth now and over the next 40 years.

The deCoste sells out most shows, facing line-ups inside and parking congestion outside. These are good problems to have, but must be addressed in this project.

The current deCoste building systems are at the end of their life. Plumbing, electrical and HVAC systems require replacement. This will reduce energy consumption and make the facility a leader in green technology for the region. We have an opportunity to improve pandemic resiliency with no touch controls, advanced air filtration, hand washing stations, etc.

TAKE **ACTION**

The overall budget for this project is \$6.7 million. The community was tasked with raising \$1.7 million, and we have only \$500,000 left to raise. This target includes capital construction, as well as the creation of an endowment fund. Investment earnings from the endowment fund will contribute to the operating costs of the library in perpetuity.

We encourage you to take action quickly so that we can acknowledge your contribution at upcoming campaign events. While there are options for quick/easy donations (phone, mail and online), we welcome an opportunity to meet with you to discuss our needs and opportunities for acknowledgement. A prominent donor wall will be placed within the new facility. There are also many opportunities for naming rights within the complex.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS







Q: Is a charitable tax receipt available for my donation to this project?

A: Yes, we can issue a charitable tax receipt for your donation.

Q: Is government committed to this project?

A: Yes, both the Town of Pictou and Municipality of Pictou County have shared a \$550,000 commitment to the project. The provincial and federal governments will contribute more than \$5 million.

Q: When will construction begin? How long will it last?

A: We anticipate launching construction by summer 2021. It is expected that construction will continue for 15 to 18 months. Our aim is for the deCoste to remain active, presenting shows throughout the construction period.

Q: Will there be opportunities to attach my family/company name to sections/elements of the new facility?

A: Yes, we have identified upwards of 30 naming opportunities to align with larger donations. We encourage you to get in touch to discuss possibilities. Donations valued at over \$500, and 'In Memory of' contributions will be recognized within the facility.

O: How do I make a donation?

A: We have various options available to make your donation and encourage you to use what is most convenient.
